

DRESS CODE

COUNTY COMPETITIONS

Skirts, tailored full length trousers and tailored cropped trousers must be white and regulation design. White shorts licensed by Bowls England, bearing the BE logo. Club coloured trousers or shorts may be worn. (Some clubs do not allow the wearing of shorts so check first). JEANS MAY NOT BE WORN. White or club coloured blouse/polo shirt with collar and sleeves. Plain waistcoat/cardigan/fleece in white or club colour. Club blazer or jacket. All team members to be dressed in the same colours. In inclement weather approved bowls waterproofs may be worn.

Hats. Head gear, if worn, should be white or club colour. Hair must be neat. Visors may be worn.

Shoes. Approved white or coloured flat-soled bowling shoes must be worn on the green. Bowling sandals are not allowed unless a Doctor's letter has been registered with the County Competition Secretary, a copy is carried at all times by the player and is renewed annually.

Umbrellas. For health and safety reasons, umbrellas are prohibited at all times on the green.

Smoking. Smoking, including e-cigarettes, during a match/competition is prohibited.

COUNTY MATCHES

Arrive and depart in Navy County Blazer, white County shirt with red/gold trim on the collar. White skirts, trousers and crops must be regulation design, or white Bowls England licensed shorts with the BE logo. Navy shoes and handbag. White County zip-up, with or without sleeves. Approved white or coloured flat-soled bowling shoes. County white showerproof jacket may be worn.

Arrive and depart in the County red zipper, white County shirt with red/gold/blue stripe. White skirts, trousers and crops must be regulation design, or white Bowls England licensed shorts with the BE logo. Navy shoes and handbag. Approved white or coloured flat-soled bowling shoes. County white showerproof jacket may be worn.
