## County Safeguarding Officer County Development Officer County Coach

These are demanding Roles which require to be filled by Individuals who have time and energy to devote to the task. All roles will be very self-fulfilling and present the opportunity for the successful applicants to both operate on their own initiative as well as being part of a team committed to producing a First-Class Coaching Strategy for the Sport of Bowls in Essex.

A pre-requisite for any Application for the Roles of County Development Officer or County Coach is that the Individual holds a current Coaching Badge from either of the two Coaching Organisations namely Coach Bowls or the English Bowls Coaches Society.

Any successful Applicant will be expected to embrace and respect both Coaching Organisations philosophies and be able to implement both Coaching organisations policies.

In respect of Applicants for the Role of County Safeguarding Officer, applications are invited from anyone not having a Coaching Badge however being a Coach would be beneficial to the post.

A successful Applicant will be expected to be conversant with all current legislation regarding Safeguarding and be able to provide practical advice where required regarding all Safeguarding Issues.

Practical and theoretical knowledge relating to vetting Procedures is a key aspect of the role. Further details regarding the 3 respective Roles and regarding the recommendations for Coaching in the future throughout Essex are contained within the Report prepared by The Essex Coaching Sub Committee.
